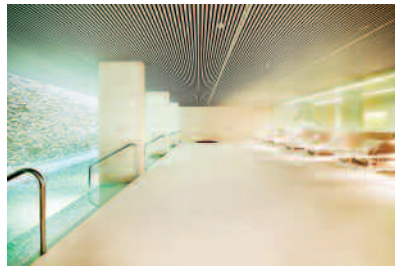

Square Nine Hotel is located on one of Belgrade's few remaining sites that allows for new construction within the historical quarter of the city. Although a contemporary building, it mingles harmoniously with neighbouring buildings by matching their colours and respecting their scale.

The hotel's concept was born from its owner's desire to be an active part of Belgrade's renovation. His dream was to create a luxurious hotel unlike the large, uninspiring hotels that had sprung up over the last 20 years from international chains with no consideration given to the city's identity. Neither a business hotel nor a leisure hotel, Square Nine needed to be the most comfortable and

welcoming hotel for all guests, whatever the purpose of their visit.

It therefore features a fully equipped conference room and business centre, a modern European cuisine restaurant, lobby bar, luxury spa including a naturally lit pool, fitness and massage rooms and a Turkish bath. A total of 45 rooms and suites offer either park or inner courtyard views and all exude a feeling of low-key elegance and cosiness.

Throughout the hotel's design and architecture, the key word is simplicity without being at all plain. Pure forms and lines, dimmed lighting and natural cladding materials such as stone, wood and leather, all combine to create an understated mood, at once fine but unpretentious.
